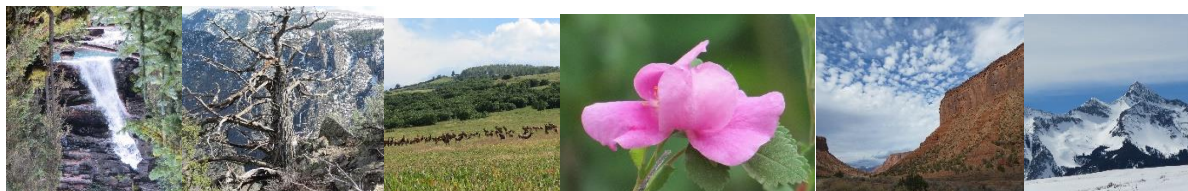
Join Public Land Managers from the Western Slope for an education on the challenges facing our local public lands and find out what you can do to help.
