- ✓ Friday, September 18th : UOCAVA ballots will be mailed to active Military/Overseas Voters
- ✓ Friday, September 25th: Public Logic & Accuracy Testing for voting system hardware (Old Courthouse, 11:00am)
- ✓ Monday, October 12th through Friday, October 16th : Ballots will be mailed to ALL active, registered voters
- ✓ Monday, October 19th: Montrose Voter Service Polling Center (VSPC) opens at the Old Courthouse
- ✓ Monday, October 26th: Last day for a voter to request a ballot to be mailed to them
- ✓ Monday, October 26th: West End Voter Service Polling Center (VSPC) opens at the Nucla-Naturita Chamber of Commerce
- ✓ Tuesday, November 3rd: ELECTION DAY– Voter Service Polling Centers open from 7:00am to 7:00pm
